



## Trustee Declaration on Appointment

Subject to provisions of the Companies Act 2006, the Articles and to any directions given by special resolution, the business of the Company shall be managed by the Directors (referred to as Trustees) who may exercise all the powers of the Company.

Trustees shall have the powers to:

- expend the funds of the Company in such manner as they shall consider most beneficial for the achievement of the Object and to invest in the name of the Company such part of the funds as they may see fit and to direct the sale or transposition of any such investments and to expend the proceeds of any such sale in furtherance of the Object;
- to enter into contracts on behalf of the Company.

*The Company's Object is specifically restricted to the following:*

*to advance for the public benefit education in the United Kingdom, in particular but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing by establishing, maintaining, carrying on, managing and developing a school with a designated Church of England religious character, offering a broad and balanced curriculum, conducted in accordance with the principles, practices and tenets of the Church of England both generally and in particular in relation to arranging for religious education and daily acts of worship (as required by the Funding Agreement), and in having regard to the advice of the Diocesan Board of Education.*

**In relation to each of our Academies, Trustees should recognise and support their individual ethos, whether or not designated Church of England.**
